#### Day 2

- Arrive in Berlin
- Meet your Klconcerts Tour Manager
- Travel to Dessau
- Arrive at the hotel for check in
- Welcome dinner
- Overnight Dessau

# Day 3

- Breakfast (daily)
- Guided city tour of Dessau including seeing the Bauhaus art school and the Bauhaus master houses (UNESCO World Heritage sites), the Georgium and Luisium parks
- Continue to Wittenberg and discover its close connection with Martin Luther and the dawn of the Protestant Reformation. See the numerous Luther sites, which are UNESCO World Heritage sites. See the Church of St. Mary, the Castle Church and the Market square

- Overnight Dessau

# Day 4

- Travel to Leipzig
- Follow the trails of world known musicians like Johann-Sebastian Bach, Felix Mendelssohn-Bartoldy or Robert & Clara Schumann
- Visit the St. Thomas church most famous as the place where Johann-Sebastian Bach worked as a cantor
- Continue to Eisleben home to the house where Martin Luther was born (1483) and the house where he died
- Arrive at the hotel for check in

- Overnight Weimar or Erfurt

# Day 5

- Travel to Eisenach, renowned for having a remarkable cultural history. Its museums, memorials and churches are of great historical importance and commemorate the life and works of a number of famous figures, including Johann Sebastian Bach and Martin Luther. Martin Luther is said to have lived here as a pupil during his school days in Eisenach from 1498-1501
- See the old quarter and the market, the palace, the Bach house and the Luther House
- Visit Wartburg Castle, which was built according to legend in 1067. This impressive castle sits in splendour on a sheer and narrow rocky outcrop overlooking the town. It is closely associated with the Reformation - this is where Martin Luther translated the New Testament into German

- Overnight Weimar or Erfurt

#### Day 6

- City tour of Erfurt where Martin Luther studied at the University in Erfurt receiving his bachelor's and master's degrees of theology
- See the Cathedral Hill (Domberg) with St. Mary's Cathedral and the Church of St. Severus, the Merchants' Bridge, Augustinian Monastery and Luther Memorial
- Travel to Weimar for a city tour. See Goethe and Schiller's houses, the Wittums Palace of Duchess Anna Amalia, the Town Church of St. Peter and St. Paul and The Weimar State Bauhaus
- Dinner
- Overnight Weimar or Erfurt

# Day 7

- Travel to Berlin. En route we visit Potsdam and see the famous Castle of Sanssouci, the royal summer residence of Frederick the Great
- Arrive at the hotel for check in
- Dinner
- Overnight Berlin

#### Day 8

- Explore the city of Berlin. See the famous sites like Alexanderplatz and TV tower, Brandenburg Gate, Victory Column, Reichstag, Postdamer Platz, Unter den Linden, Staatsoper Unter den Linden, Tiergarten (Zoo), The Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church and Kurfürstendamm

#### Day 9

- Visit the Sachsenhausen concentration camp. This camp was one of the first detention facilities established by the Nazis when they gained power in 1933. It held the Nazis' political opponents from the Berlin region
