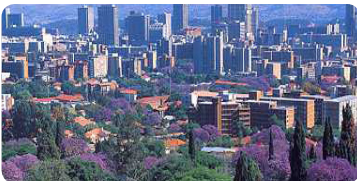

Day 2

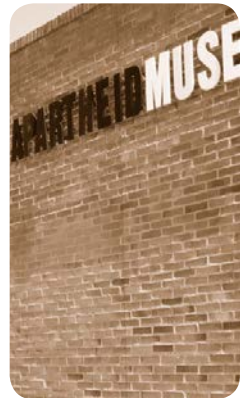

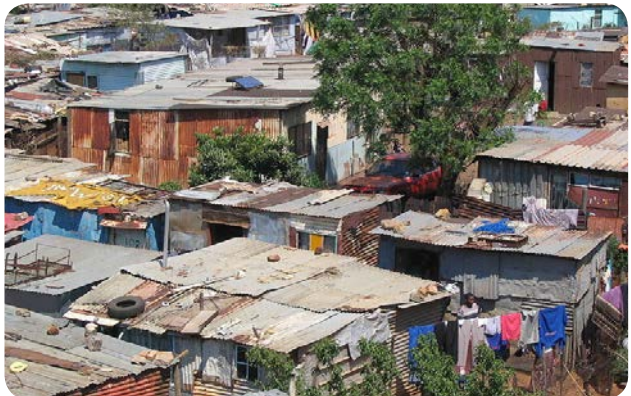

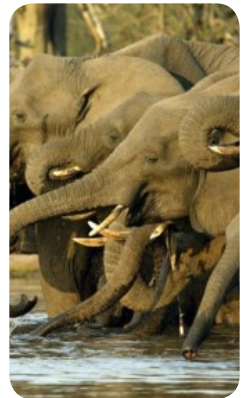
